BEGINNING WEDNESDAY
JUNE 22nd AT 7:00 pm

Did you know that the term “one another” is used 9 times in the New Testament to teach us about how we should live as community together? In fact, the words “one another” are an indication that we cannot live and do the Christian life on our own at all. Our lives are to be lived with “one another.” This is a necessary part of our discipleship process – the process of becoming deeply devoted followers of Jesus so much that the way we live our lives reflects Christ’s presence to the world.



Saint James has a discipleship process – a way to make and mature disciples. Here is a brief rundown of that process:

1. Someone comes/is invited to an event/concert/worship and is greeted with by Worship Welcome Team and should be introduced to a Guest Service person who will begin to develop a relationship with our guest(s).
- 1.5 Congregation should engage in the 10-foot rule before service (that is to meet and greet everyone who is within 10 feet of you) and “3 Minute Rule” after worship where you spend 3 minutes meeting people you do not know.
2. After 6-8 visits, guests will be assigned a Shepherd
3. Also at this time guests will be invited to a meet and greet with the Pastor following worship.
4. In getting to know our guests better, we can begin to see where they are on their journey with Jesus. This will allow us to help direct them to a small group which will provide information about the faith (knowledge/Bible Studies) based on where they are. Options available at this time are:

The Daily Bible Study in the weekly Bulletin
Discovery Nights and Sunday School Class

Kingdoms Seekers is an entry level learning of the Bible
Men’s and Women’s Wednesday Classes are a little further along
Sunday Night Study is a little further in the journey
Music groups are small groups where music and prayer lead to worship

This summer we will be adding the 5th and last step of our discipleship process, the DLT Groups. DLT Stands for “Doing Life Together.” It is the place where we take the information from study we have obtained and learn to live it out intentionally with “one another.” In other words, we need to take our information and let it seep into our lives so that we begin to experience transformation which is what the Bible is all about!

So starting on Wednesday, June 22nd, we will begin teaching and experiencing what Doing Life Together looks like. We will worship at 6:30 and beginning at 7:00 we will start learning and implementing the DLT Groups (Doing Life Together Groups).

Come out and learn what a blessing this is and watch what God will do with our willingness to “Do Life Together.” We will never be the same!

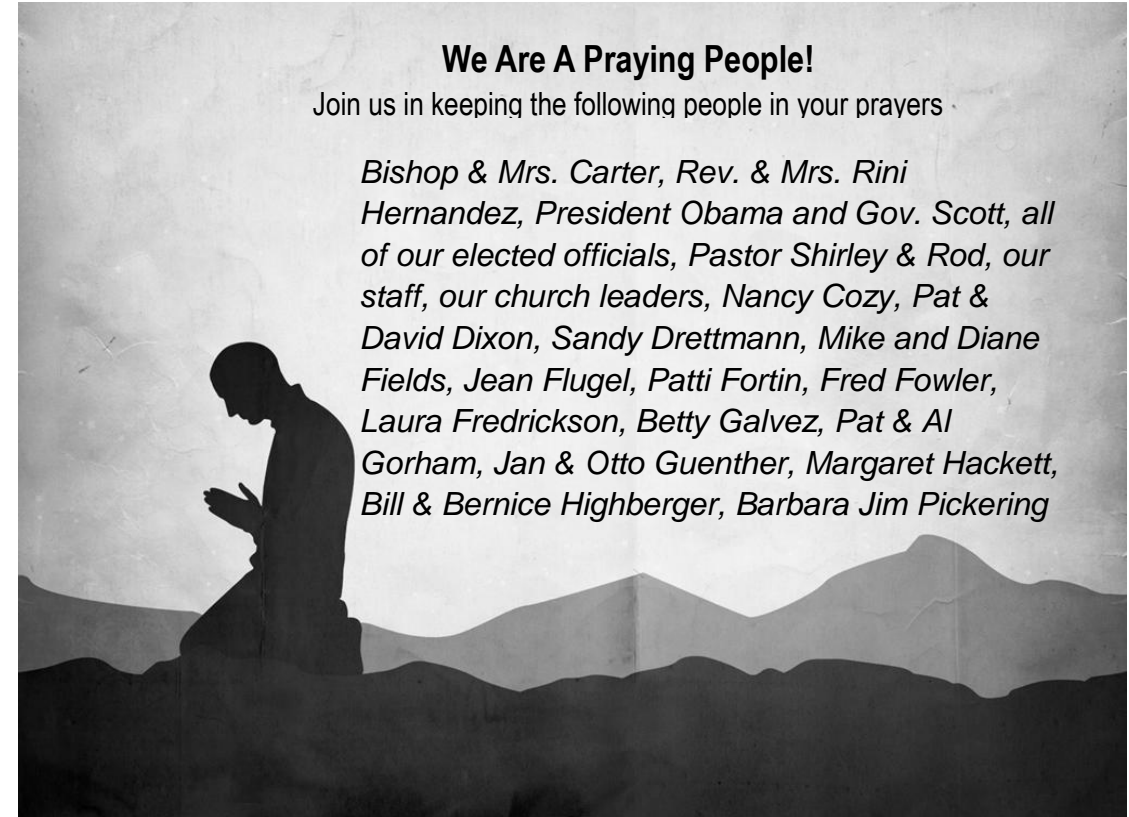
SPRING CLEANING DAY – June 4 @ 9:00 am
