

Happy October everyone. I am so looking forward to that first cool front finally making it down here. This month, my article is sharing an email (with permission) that I received. My hope is you will find encouragement in it and see that your efforts and friendship are not going unnoticed. Enjoy.

I had some thoughts this morning that I would like to share with you. Please know that the ONLY reason we left St. James is because when we moved, we had to go to a church near us. We didn't have the online ability we enjoy today. Maybe that is a blessing from COVID. Thank you so much for providing us the ability to stay connected and worship with New Beginnings Community Church (ST. James). I was thinking about why we came to St James - what made us join. It was kind of like this:

- 1. The members of the congregation treated us like old friends the first time we came. They continued to treat us like family and friends the entire time we were attending the church in person.
- 2. The message while we really enjoyed you and your style very much, your messages really resonated with us. Speaking to us at a level that was more like a close communication than a lecture and sharing what you believe from the depths of your soul was hugely important to us.
- 3. Prayer ministry. The sense of belonging we felt was made even stronger by the prayers of the church and congregation.
- 4. Service format. The format of the services is always interesting and engaging. This is also one of the reasons we stayed.
- 5. Outreach opportunities. We are always busy at home usually working. So, we feel connected by participating in different local outreach ministries. Helping with bags of hope, the music, and now that we are too far away for hands on, the chance to help financially when we can. We don't have a lot but give extra when possible.
- 6. The music. We love the blend of old and new music. Funny that this is the last of our reasons to be there when I am a musician in my soul. Praise through music is very important. But even acapella is praise through music. It doesn't have to be perfect just heartfelt. And at St. James it is heartfelt. We came back because we missed the family connection we have there. When we retired, we moved here to be closer to family. It is a blessing and a curse. We do get to see our oldest son maybe once a year since we are closer. But we still don't see the others. My message to those who want to move to be closer to family is this. Only do it if you have a financial or physical need to be close to them. This has happened to me twice in my life. I get it now. Anyway, I wanted to share these thoughts with you because although music, setting and service format are very important, the most important things are the connection of the congregation and the message of truth being delivered.

Please be sure to include a check made out to Saint James for \$10 to cover the shipping charges if you are filling a box the traditional way.

With just a few clicks, you can pack an Operation Christmas Child shoebox gift online to help share God's love with a boy or girl in need around the world. Simply select toys and other fun items you'd like to include from the collection, and personalize your gift with your own letter and photo. We'll pack the gift for you and send it on its way for a suggested donation of just \$25. The website is Samaritanspurse.org. Select the "What We Do" tab at the top of the page, then Operation Christmas Child and then towards the bottom of the tab select Build a Shoebox Online tab to get started. If you fill your shoebox on line, please let the office know so we can keep track of the number of boxes we donate.

The boxes will be available Sunday, October 16<sup>th</sup> and must be returned by November 13<sup>th</sup> so they can be delivered the following week to the collection center.
